

# Kim's Magic Blankets



## Before you get started...

- No rules when making these blankets
- Any type of yarn can be used
- Any hook or needle size can be used, whatever you are most comfortable with
- If knitting, no open stitches (i.e. use garter or stocking stitch)
- Aim for about 107cm square (minimum)

## Kim's pattern is for crocheted blankets. Kim uses:

- 7mm hook
- 2 strands of 8ply DK yarn worked together
  - You can also use worsted weight, aran weight, 4 ply, or whatever weight of yarn you have on hand or are comfortable working with.
- One continuous colour throughout (such as white or black) & one ball of 8 ply scraps (any colour or length randomly joined together)

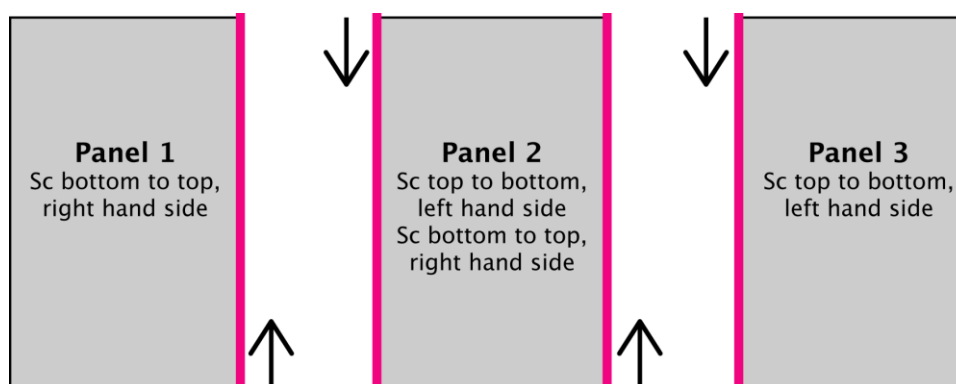
## US terms. Make 3 panels. Panel:

- Foundation dc 35. Slst 2, turn.
- In same dc as slst, dc. Dc across foundation row (35 stitches).
- Repeat for 60 rows.

## To join once you have 3 panels:

- Sc 1 row up the right side of panel 1. Tie off.
- Sc 1 row down the left side of panel 2. Tie off.
- Sc 1 row up the right side of panel 2. Tie off.
- Sc 1 row down the left side of panel 3. Tie off.
- Whip stitch between the lines of sc with the same colour, or any joining stitch that you prefer.



## To finish:

- 2x rows of sc around the entire blanket, with 3 sc in each corner.
